MENU OF REWARDS



For individual pupils;



Children are awarded with a **Brilliant Behaviour badge** when they have earned 50, 100, 150, 200 and 250 class dojo points (this replaces behaviour wristbands). Badges are given to pupils in Celebration assembly each Friday. As such, each teacher should share results of class dojo with pupils each week.

Pupils should wear their latest badge to school every day.

Once badges have been received, children will enter the 50 Club, 100 Club etc. This entitles pupils to specific extra rewards given at timely intervals.



Half termly – Year group with the most Class dojos;

A class reward will be awarded to the class with the most Class dojo points at the end of each half term. The class with the most class dojos will be announced in the final Celebration assembly of each half term.



Rewards are chosen by the principal from the following list as suggested by our pupils;

Extra playtime	Minecraft/Lego session	BMX session
Art & Craft session	Cookery session	Free time on devices



WHOLE SCHOOL REWARD



A whole school reward will be given when all classes have achieved against an agreed whole school behaviour focus target. Targets will be shared by the principal at the start of each term.

The whole school reward will be agreed with a key group of pupils and the principal from the following list as suggested by our pupils;
