In Science we will be learning about Fossils and the Great Lakes. We will also attempt to memorise Science 'Killer Facts'.



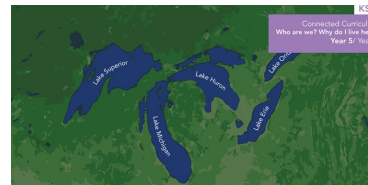
In PHSE we will be learning about living in the wider world. We will identify current issues in the media concerning health and wellbeing. Explain rules and laws. As well as the Importance of human rights
