In literacy we will be writing a recount based on our trip and writing a diary entry from the point of view of someone living in the Stone Age. We will also focus on using capital letters and a range of punctuation correctly to achieve the fullest effect in our writing.

In Numeracy we will be learning about the place value of 3 digit numbers and 10 and 100 less than a given number. We will then move on to add and subtract using both written methods and mental strategies.

In Science we will identify how animals and humans get nutrition from what they eat and understand what this would have been like for people living in the Stone Age.



In PHSE we will learn about relationships and develop skills like compromise and co-operation.

In Computing we will focus on coding, ensuring that the children know how to design and write a program and use repetition commands. This will be done using the Purple Mash scheme of work.
